



# Walkerville Bowling & Community Club inc. Bylaws

The Clubrooms, Bar and Greens are open at the discretion of Board of Management and also the Bar Manager and Greens master.

## 1 DRESS AND DECORUM

- 1.1 Members are expected to wear neat casual dress and to behave in a manner That upholds the dignity of the Walkerville Bowling & Community Club.
- 1.2 For all Pennant/League matches and for all official fixtures, unless otherwise expressly advised, official dress on the green shall be – in accordance with Bowls Australia and/or Bowls SA.
- 1.3 All players Umpires and Markers, including visitors, shall wear flat soled shoes in accordance with Bowls Australia and/or Bowls SA.
- 1.4 Men shall NOT wear hats or caps within the Clubrooms
- 1.5 If an official fixture is in progress, no person may practice on any Green without permission of the Tournament Manager or Greens Manager for the day.

## 2 VISITORS

- 2.1 A member may introduce visitors to play bowls or use the Clubrooms on any occasion that they are open. In accordance with the requirements of the Liquor Licensing act.

## 3 DISCIPLINARY ACTION

- 3.1 See Constitution and Rules last checked 11<sup>th</sup> June 2018

- 1.1.1 Any member removed from the Board for not following the Board's direction or conducting business not approved by the Board, shall not hold any position on the Club's Board, for the tenure of their membership of the Walkerville Bowling and Community Club inc.

## 2 TOURNAMENTS

- 2.1 All final Tournaments played on an allocated day (that the Tournament Director has allocated) shall wear Club Uniform. All other finals played on any other day shall wear neat casual. All special Tournaments dress as per Tournament director.

## 3 CONSTITUTIONS

- 3.1 Constitution to be available to all members at all times. A copy to be in the Clubrooms at all times.

3.2 All New Members are told in writing that a constitution is available to borrow at any time.

#### 4 CLUB BYLAWS

4.1 Club Bylaws to be always available to all members. A copy to be always in the Clubrooms.

#### 5 POSITIONS ON COMMITTEES

5.1 Board of Management as per Constitution.

7.1.2 Anyone taking on the position of President, Secretary or Treasurer must be a Full Member for 2 years before taking on any of the above Positions.

7.1.3 Office Bearers only pay Bowls SA Affiliation fee and do not need to Pay the Club Membership Fee.

5.2 Nomination forms to be filled out and handed to the Secretary at least seven days before the Annual General Meeting for the following positions.

- Ladies Selection Manager
- Men's Selection Manager

5.3 Nomination forms are not required to be filled out for the following positions but will be selected on or after the AGM.

- Bar
- Greens Manager
- Social – Raffles
- Functions
- House - Cleaning
- Sponsorship
- Publicity Officer
- Auditor
- Bowls Coordinator
- Tournament - Ladies & Men by 2
- And any other Committee people required for the smooth running of the Bowls.

#### 6 GENERAL REGULATIONS

6.1 It is the responsibility of all Members in putting away anything that has been used and keeping the Clubrooms and Greens tidy.

6.2 A fee will be charged for the supply of the afternoon tea on Pennant/League days. Cost will be determined each year by the Caterer or the Board of Management.

## 7 CARE OF THE GREENS

7.1 The Greens are the most important asset of the Club and as such should be treated with the greatest of care as well as giving consideration to other users.

Please avoid any unnecessary standing, walking, dropping of bowls or any action likely to damage the surface of the green or to annoy other bowlers.

7.2 Members are required to wear smooth soles shoes when using the Greens, even if some relaxation of this rule has been made for non-members such as night owls.

7.3 Members are required at all times to follow the directions of the Greens Manager or his deputy as to the use of the Greens. Such directions may be given directly or per the green's notice board and may relate to availability of rinks or Greens or may give a special instruction such actions to be avoided.

## 8 LIFE MEMBERS

The Board may decide to Nominate a Life Member at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) outside of the rules of the Constitution, provided that there are no more than one twelfth of Club members.
